

KINDERGARTEN TERM 1 OVERVIEW



READING

In first term, our focus is to instill and foster a love of reading. We will focus on choosing 'good fit' books which are interesting, and learning how to 'read the pictures' to make meaning. Enjoying books at home with your child and asking them to retell familiar stories may support their learning.

WRITING

Students will have opportunities to engage in role-play writing, to build their confidence and excitement about writing. They will also be supported to develop fine motor skills. Asking to read texts your child has written and encouraging their attempts may develop their abilities.

MATHEMATICS



In first term, the focus in number will be identifying dot patterns up to 10, identifying numbers and quantities up to 10 and comparing quantities up to 10. Playing dice games and counting forwards and backwards is useful.

Students will explore words which describe the location of everyday objects using positional language (above, below, behind, next to) and compare the lengths of different objects.

INQUIRY

Geography: Students will investigate the school environment, exploring who belongs here, what makes this place special and how we can look after it. Talking about the importance of school rules may be beneficial.

Science: Students will begin a unit about living things, looking at what they need to survive.
