

KINDERGARTEN TERM 2 OVERVIEW



READING

In Term 2, students will be beginning to read short books, using their letter sound knowledge, camera words and understanding of the pictures. Students will continue to learn about different reading comprehension strategies. Encouraging your child to read every day is a great support.

WRITING

Students will begin to write sentences that make sense and use full stops at the end. They will use their understanding of letter sounds to spell short words and write for different purposes. At home, you can celebrate all attempts at writing to build your child's confidence.

MATHEMATICS

Students will be learning to add two numbers up to 10. They will also learn to represent addition stories in different ways, such as using counters or drawing a picture. Another focus will be recalling the days of the week in order and identifying events which occur on different days. Talking about the days of the week with your child at home may assist them. In algebra, students will be learning about repeating patterns. Throughout the term, we will also revise numeral formation and counting forwards and backwards from ten.

INQUIRY

At the beginning of Term 2, students will complete their Living Things inquiry unit by comparing the needs of themselves to another living thing. Students will also begin a history inquiry unit. They will explore their family's histories and learn about events that happened in the past.
