

KINDERGARTEN TERM 3 OVERVIEW



READING

In Term 3, students will continue to read short books, using their letter sound knowledge, camera words and understanding of the pictures. We are learning different comprehension, accuracy, fluency and expanding vocabulary strategies to extend our reading knowledge.

WRITING

Students will begin to write sentences that make sense and use full stops at the end. They will use their understanding of letter sounds to spell short words and write for different purposes. At home, you could talk to your child about their writing goal.

MATHEMATICS

Students will be learning to read, write and represent numbers up to 20. They will understand that teen numbers are made up of one ten and a few extra ones. Students will also count forwards and backwards to 20 from different starting points. Finding numbers around the house and in the world may help students' recognition. In geometry students will sort, describe and name familiar two dimensional shapes and three dimensional objects in the environment. Students will also explore mass and decide which object is heavier using direct and indirect comparisons.

INQUIRY

From week 2 to week 8, we will be learning all about weather! This interesting Science unit has two essential questions:

- *How do we share changes in the weather with others?*
- *How do the seasons affect our lives?*

At home, you could do some weather noticing and decide on activities and outfits that suit the weather.
