

# 3/4 TERM 3 OVERVIEW



## READING

Students will continue to develop their reading fluency and comprehension through Reader's Workshop. Students will focus on a range of strategies including sequencing, summarising, fact and opinion, inferring and author's purpose.

## WRITING

This term, students will explore recounts and retells. They will demonstrate an understanding of grammar, punctuation and vocabulary related to this text type. In week 6 students will begin persuasive writing.

## YEAR 3 MATHEMATICS

- Unit fractions.
- Patterns and addition and subtraction expressions.

- Picture and bar graphs.

## YEAR 4 MATHEMATICS

- Fractions and decimals.
- Connecting addition and subtraction.
- Telling time to the nearest minute & finding elapsed time.
- Tables, columns, picture graphs.
