READING

This term, students will be engaging with a variety of strategies to comprehend different text types. They will be learning about the importance of using Comprehension, Accuracy, Fluency, and Expanded Vocabulary (CAFE) when reading.

WRITING

This term, students will have the opportunity to engage in speech writing for a number of leadership roles within the school community. A focus on using persuasive devices within a range of contexts will be explored through the writing process.

YEAR 5 MATHEMATICS

- Place value - decimal place value
- Place value - comparing and ordering decimals
- Measurement - using mental and written strategies to solve number problems

YEAR 6 MATHEMATICS

- Place value - positive and negative integers
- Place value - multiplying and dividing by the power of ten
- Measurement - comparing different units of measurement
