## READING

The focus in Term 1 will be supporting students to find and engage with 'good fit' books. Students will learn strategies to assist with understanding what they read, how to decode words, improving their fluency and expanding their vocabulary.

## WRITING

Our focus this term will be on writing effective recounts and engaging narratives. Students will use everyday events and personal interests to develop their writing. Students will continue to grow their knowledge of spelling patterns and appropriate punctuation.

## MATHEMATICS

### Junior

- Place value and recognition of 2 and 3 digit numbers
- Addition and subtraction strategies
- Telling time to the hour



### Senior

- Place value and recognition of numbers up to 100,000
- Multiplication facts to  $10 \times 10$
- Telling time to the minute and an understanding of 12 and 24 hour time
