- I understand that the ACT Government (the Territory) does not meet all claims for injury, disease or illness to students resulting from school activities or school organised excursions. Claims are only met where there is a liability to do so. Liability is not automatic and depends on the circumstances in which the injury was sustained. I understand I should obtain my own advice about insurance protection which may assist in meeting expenses if my child is injured in circumstances where there is no liability on the part of the Territory. The ACT Ambulance Service provides free ambulance transport for students who are injured or suddenly become ill at school or during school-approved activities within the ACT.
