The colour powder used in our event has been sourced direct from India, the home of Holi Powder. It is made of high-quality corn starch and permitted food colours. It's non-toxic, biodegradable, skin safe and environmentally friendly. Toxicological Risk Assessment and ingredient listings can be obtained from the Front Office upon request. Students with asthma are advised to be careful in their decision to participate. Staff will aim to throw powder at the torso, however wind and other factors can cause the powder to protrude on the face. All students will receive a pair of sunglasses to wear on the day and powder stations will be set up in areas where students can choose to walk around and opt out from being covered in powder if they wish.

PLEASE NOTE: If you fill in this form, your personal information and that of your child will be collected and handled by the ACT Education Directorate (ETD) (Monash School). This information is necessary for us to be able to manage student participation in excursions, and support the welfare and safety of your child. If you do not consent to supply us with this information your child will be unable to participate in the excursion. I understand that the ACT Government (the Territory) does not meet all claims for injury, disease or illness to students resulting from school activities or school organised excursions. Claims are only met where there is a liability to do so. Liability is not automatic and depends on the circumstances in which the injury was sustained. I understand I should obtain my own advice about insurance protection which may assist in meeting expenses if my child is injured in circumstances where there is no liability on the part of the Territory. The ACT Ambulance Service provides free ambulance transport for students who are injured or suddenly become ill at school or during school-approved activities within the ACT. Excursions to states and territories outside the ACT are not covered by free ambulance transport. In serious cases where medical attention is necessary, and a parent/carer is not available, I authorise the school to make arrangements for the welfare of my child (including transport and medical/surgical treatment). I agree that my child/children will be under the authority of the school for the duration of the excursion and that the school is authorised to return the student home at the expense of the parent/carer if the school considers that circumstances of unacceptable behaviour warrant such action.
