As part of the Year 5/6 Business and Economics unit of work, students will be investigating the importance of budgeting to create a successful business based on data collected from consumers. Students will be exploring why it is important to be informed when making consumer and financial decisions.

Students will:

- identify the purpose of their business and recognise the different ways that businesses choose to provide goods and services;
- plan and create a successful business plan based on data;
- plan, organise and run a market stall on a budget, with the intention of making a profit.

Mini Market Day is an event where students participate in a range of fun activities. The funds raised go towards the Year 6 gift to the school.

Students are able to purchase tickets that will enable them to buy various items or participate in a variety of activities at the Mini Market Day. Some stalls may require 1 or 2 tickets to participate.



\$5.00 (book of 10 tickets – maximum of 2 books per student)

Tickets will be handed out on Mini Market Day.



Some of the fun filled activities may include: 'Crazy Cans' – knocking cans down with balls (or water balloons), 'Crazy Drinks' – spiders (ice cream and soft drink), 'Dip 'n' Win' – put your hand in slime and jelly to win a prize, 'Squirt 'em up' – shoot a target using water guns, and 'Throw, Splat, Win' – throwing water balloons to win lollies.

This is a uniform free day for the school. No thongs, singlet tops or short shorts. Please remember your hat! There will be water activities, so a change of clothes might also be worthwhile.
